William Bar william Erham Barr (born May 23, 1950) is an American lawyer and government official who has served as the 85th U.S. Attorney General in the Donald Trump administration since February 14, 2019. He also served as the 77th Attorney General from 1991 to 1993 during the George H.W. Bush administration. From 1973 to 1977, Bar was hired by the Central Intelligence Agency when he was in school. He then served as a legal clerk to judge Malcolm Richard Wilkie. In the 1980s, Barr worked at law firm Show, Pittman, Potts & Trowbridge, where he worked for a year at the White House under Ronald Reagan's administration dealing with the law. Before becoming Attorney General in 1991, Barr led the Attorney General's Office (OLC) and served in many posts within the Department of Justice, including serving as Deputy Attorney General. From 1994 to 2008, Barr worked in corporate law for GTE and its successor Verizon Communications, which made him a millionaire. From 2009 to 2018, Bar served on Time Warner's Board of Directors. Bar is a long-standing supporter of the unified executive theory of near-free presidential authority over the executive branch of the U.S. government. In 1989, the bar justified the U.S. invasion of Panama to arrest Manuel Noriega as head of the OLC. As Deputy Attorney General, Barr approved an FBI operation that freed hostages at The Talladega Federal Prison in 1991. Attorney General Barr, a leading supporter of tougher criminal justice policies, wrote a report, Cases for More Incarceration, as Attorney General in 1992, claiming an increase in the U.S. incarceration rate. Under bar advice, in 1992 President George H.W. Bush granted amnesty to six officials involved in the Iran-Contra case. Barr became Attorney General for the second time in 2019. That year, under his leadership, the Justice Department insisted on disabling affordable care laws and reviving the death penalty for federal crimes. In 2019, Barr was detained by Congressional criminal contempt for dissoning a subpoena. His department refused to prosecute him. Barr, who criticized Mueller's investigation before taking office, did not step down from oversurfing the investigation as attorney general. After Mueller's report, he issued a four-page letter to Congress explaining that what he said was the main conclusion, adding his opinion that the evidence presented did not establish obstruction of justice by Trump. Special Counsel Mueller privately replied that Barr's letter had faked the report. After the release of a revised version of the actual report, fact checkers and news organizations also said that bar letters misunderstood the report. On December 9, 2019, a report from the Justice Department's inspector general found many mistakes, errors and inemanity in the handling of the Russian investigation, but found no evidence of testimony or documentary that political prejudice against Trump had stroded the start of the investigation. Within hours of the release of the IG report, bar publicly announced disagreements with the report's findings. The next day, the bar claimed in an interview with NBC News that the Russia investigation was completely unfounded and said the FBI investigation may have been dishonest. Faith.
